
Guard dies at Deseret Depot

A 26-year employee of Deseret Chemical Depot collapsed and died Sunday at noon in the facility's parking lot.

Terry Stonebreaker, 56, of Lehi worked at the depot as a security guard. He had just finished his shift when he collapsed. Emergency personnel were called in and he was taken to Mountain West Medical Center where he was pronounced dead.

Stonebreaker leaves behind a wife and three children.

Alaine Southworth, spokeswoman for the depot, said Mr. Stonebreaker suffered from an undisclosed medical condition.
